Minutes:

1. With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 7:35pm.
2. Minutes from May 13, 2010 meeting were reviewed and approved.
3. National Night Out will be held on August 3, 2010 in the Target parking lot between the hours of 6:00pm and 9:00pm. The far side of the parking lot has been designated to house the event and it will be marked off by orange cones and/or police tape. All Safety Committee members are requested to be at the parking lot no later than 5:30pm on that date. Points raised during the discussion:
 - a) We have a \$500 budget and will receive an additional \$250 donation from Target.
 - b) Marvin and Monroe also approached our Target for sponsorship. Target went with Wesley Chapel because we were the first to approach them.
 - c) Target will arrange for Union County sheriff's representation at the event as well as their store security.
 - d) Butch Plyler will be contacted about fire department representation, either Wesley Chapel or Baker.
 - e) Barbequing and/or serving food is not permitted because of health concerns. Target will investigate if it's possible to have a pop-corn machine. A snow cone machine was also suggested.
 - f) Target will supply some smaller items; Harris Teeter will also be approached as will Chic-fil-A and Brooklyn Pizza.
 - g) Tess will check with the Union County sheriff's office for hand outs, ident-i-kits, etc.
 - h) We are looking for a volunteer DJ and/or band.
 - i) A bounce house was suggested for the kids.

- j) No live animals are permissible.
- k) Donations will be accepted from any/all businesses.
- l) Banners, which are reusable from year to year will be purchased in order to help with the advertising.
- m) Teen volunteers are being sought for face painting, hair coloring with paint and other such activities.
- n) Adult tables are needed as well. These tables can supply information about HOA's, village committees and other valuable village information.
- o) We may request tables to be loaned for this event, dependent upon how many Target is able to supply.
- p) Also discussed having a t-shirt design contest for the 2011 National Night Out.
- q) Media coverage is needed.
- r) Committee members to contact the HOA's and advise Tess of who was contacted.

4. Contract Deputy Update

- a) Target reports an increase in store crime (shoplifting) and vandalism to customer and employee vehicles.
- b) No soliciting signs will be posted in the parking lot(s).
- c) Ashton Properties and JDH have been contacted via a council approved letter seeking the financial support from the businesses to share the cost of a contract deputy on a 33% split with the village. The deadline to respond was June 11th; as of the 15th no responses had been received.
- d) The Villages 33% would be covered under the capital improvement plan.
- e) It was commented that Safety Committee representation at the village council meetings could help sway the council to support the contract deputy initiative.

5. Relay List. Tess and Donna will meet and review/update the list as needed.

6. The next meeting is July 13th at 7:30 at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church.
