Minutes:

1. With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 6:06pm.
2. Minutes from the September 22, 2011 meeting were reviewed and approved with changes to the December meeting date; changing December 13th to December 12th in order to meet on the same day as Council.
3. Committee Members
  - a) Elwood J. "Jim" Dale was introduced to the Safety Committee. Jim is originally from Boston and his most recent experience was with 7-Eleven where he developed their "Operation Chill" national program that allowed kids performing good deeds to receive coupons for free slurpees.
4. National Night Out Follow-Up
  - a) The Target donation is being pursued; no update
  - b) Follow-up on the plaques presentations for assisting with our National Night Out. Kim and Carol presented AJ and the Explorers with their plaque; Carol and Tess presented Station 31 with their plaque; Kim presented the Sheriff's office with their plaque; EMS still remains to be done and perhaps can be accomplished on February 15th at our meeting. Tess has tried to reach out to the EMS contact; perhaps Carol will have better luck.
  - c) The night was a success. A couple of suggestions were brought up to improve the experience in 2012, such as food being served and that the Safety Committee should begin planning in February for this event. It was also mentioned that AJ Mainero and Sheriff Cathy will participate.
5. Special Project Discussions

- a) Contract Deputy AJ Mainero started December 1st. AJ will work out of our Town Hall; all other deputies will work out of the satellite office at the new fire station on Indian Trail - Waxhaw Road.
  - b) All were pleased to hear that for crime reporting purposes, Wesley Chapel now has its own zone. The village is represented as Zone 12 for the statistical reports.
  - c) Re-write of the Safety Committee's charter should be pursued. The current charter will be redistributed by Kim. Ideas/thoughts/comments due to Tess by January 6, 2012.
6. New Business
- a) Schedule for upcoming meetings: February 15, 2012; April 10, 2012; June 12, 2012; July 10, 2012. All being at 7:00pm. These meetings are currently slated for Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church.
  - b) AJ Mainero was presented to the Safety Committee this evening pursuant to his introduction to the Village Council.
  - c) Discussion ensued about code red emergency messages by phone. Addresses and contacts have to be correct so the validation works. Chauncey will provide the link.
  - d) A meet and greet should be planned with AJ for after the holidays and the schools should be involved.
  - e) In 2011 we achieved securing a contract deputy and a successful National Night Out. Our focus for 2012 should be how to get crime prevention out in the focus of the community.
