The Safety Committee Met at the Town Hall for Wesley Chapel at New Town Rd,  
Wesley Chapel, N.C.

Attendance: Mayor Brad Horvath, Donna Pasciuta, Hank Pressley, Chauncey Bowers  
Absent: Tessie Morris( Arrived late)and Andy Combs

Guests: Carol Mullis

Minutes:

1. With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order
2. Mayor Horvath spoke and informed the committee that Kim Ormiston would be taking his position as liaison to the committee.
3. Discussions re: cost of Security Officer/Contract Deputy
  - Chauncey asked if we knew if the Commercial owners in the town's center would chip in for security for Wesley Chapel.
  - This was open for discussion and it was decided that this would be brought up at future meetings.
  - Resident Carol Mullis stated that when Brian was on the Committee and in previous years security was not needed
  - Hank suggested that we ask local towns about their security needs  
This will be further researched by the committee and feedback will be given
  - Our crime statistics have increased since JDH and Ashton properties have increased their stores. It has also increased with the vandalism from HOA's and close by neighborhoods due to kids "hanging around here"
4. Counsel was asked for an update from each committee every other month. Brad gave us an update on the last meeting. 38 people attended. Discussions were about parks and better communication between the counsel, citizens and the committees.  
Brad does attend the Planning Board Meeting. There was discussion of changing or updating gun and town or property ordinances. Town Hall topics in motion as well as a Contract Deputy and Operating Expenses. Price Mill family has donated 12 acres to the Village.
5. The Village is to announce: Community Forum which is being held May 3<sup>rd</sup>, as a Joint Meeting with other Committees and Residents at the 7:00 pm at the United Methodist Church

6. New Business:

Meeting prior to this date to get the word out
  
- Committee to take a look at Ordinances and Safety Issues  
If improvement is needed; then bring suggestions to the Counsel
  - a. Carol asked if there are Ordinances for Homeland Security issues  
Especially with the two schools; New Town and Wesley Chapel Elementary
- Wesley Chapel is working on defining Sub-Ordinances and Zoning Ordinances.
- Speed Limit 35 on only Waxhaw Indian Trail road; it needs to be asked to be for all four directions.
- Fire House: Further discussion regarding the size, location and having 2 paid firemen with sleeping quarters with the majority of calls coming in being EMS. There was discussion of the possibility of the North Side being able to house a Sheriff
  - a. Chauncey asked if the Firehouse can have an EMS Station on the other two acres that were donated.
  - b. Carol Mullis wanted to commend Brad and Counsel for working in getting the new firehouse underway
- Blue Number signs for residents mailboxes
  - a. Carol Mullis stated that this could be a fundraising event
- Spring Safety Event; Tessie not available; discussed possibly have an event in October
- Counsel Approved National Night Out
- Downtown Committee is proposing Store and living upstairs, or Senior Care as a possible suggestion for future development in Wesley Chapel. Currently 25% of Wesley Chapels population work at home.
