1. ADDITIONS, DELETIONS, AND / OR ADOPTION OF AGENDA

2. PUBLIC COMMENTS

3. APPROVAL OF MARCH 15, 2012 MINUTES  
Haley moved to approve the minutes. Bailey seconded. Unanimous vote, yes.
4. UPDATE ON BUDGET REQUESTS
