The Village Council of Wesley Chapel, North Carolina met in the Town Hall at 6490 Weddington Road, Wesley Chapel in North Carolina.

Council Present: Mayor Kapfhammer and Council Members Como and Kaperonis

Council Absent: Mayor Pro Tem Kenary, Council Member Rodriguez

Others Present: Clerk/Finance Officer Cheryl Bennett

1. Determination of quorum

Mayor Kapfhammer led the Pledge of Allegiance and a quorum was present.

2. Request to Union County to contribute \$100,000 towards a roundabout at Potter and Potter Roads being applied for under STP-DA funding

Council Member Kaperonis motioned to request Union County contribute \$100,000 towards a roundabout at Potter and Potter Roads being applied for under STP-DA funding. No second was made.

Council Member Como stated we have yet to hear from engineers that it will make the traffic better, and we didn't give an opportunity to the people to express their opinions.

Mayor Kapfhammer stated DOT engineers have expressed it is of value and that is why it is on their list. After spending several days trying to pull council members together for a meeting, he had to call a meeting with just six hours' notice. This is just to get us in line for free funding.

Council Member Kaperonis noted it is being pro-active to get the money; we don't know for sure it will happen, but this is to get us in line.

Mayor Kapfhammer added we can still have a public hearing, and if the public wants to keep the traffic, we can tell the State that we don't want traffic alleviation.

Council Member Como said he thinks it is the burden of the State to address the problem, it should not be for us to pay \$275,100 (the 21% match).

Council Member Kaperonis added if we don't vote for this, there is no chance to get the \$100,000.

3. Adjournment

Council Member Como motioned to adjourn; Council Member Kaperonis seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
