SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Village Council of Wesley Chapel, North Carolina met in the Town Hall at 6490 Weddington Road, Wesley Chapel, North Carolina.

**Council Present:** Mayor Pro Tem Kaperonis, Council Members Como and Fuller

**Council Absent:** Mayor Horvath, Council Member Rodriguez

**Others Present:** Clerk/Finance Officer Cheryl Bennett

1. Pledge of Allegiance, Invocation and Determination of quorum

Mayor Pro Tem Kaperonis led the Pledge of Allegiance and the invocation was given. A quorum was present.

2. Consider approval of budget for park Rock N roll event on July 27, 2019 of \$3,320

Park and Rec Chair John Lepke noted he has one band available and willing to play for \$500, and he would like to get two additional bands. The sound technician makes adjustments for each band, and he has someone who is familiar with our system. He was concerned whether bands would have W-9 forms and Certificates of Insurance which we normally require. Two banners will be purchased, and publicity will be through a press release, flyers, and social media. Three off-duty deputies will be hired, plus our contract deputy. Parking will be mainly at the Church across the street, and there will be some ADA spaces. The car show will use the rest of the parking lot, and if the weather is good cars could also park on the grassy area. There will be two food trucks. Volunteers will be obtained through a sign up genius site. Trophies will be awarded to the first, second and third place cars, as voted by participants. If it rains, the event will be cancelled. The contract calls for the bands to get a 30% deposit which they can keep; if we can book them at a future event, we will pay the remainder then.

Council Member Como motioned to approve up to \$3,400 for the July 27, 2019 event, subject to clarifying the insurance and W-9's. Council Member Fuller seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously.

3. Adjournment

Mayor Pro Tem Kaperonis motioned to adjourn; Council Member Como seconded the motion.
